The following materials are collected by our curbside collection program: newspaper; mixed paper; paperboard; aluminum and tin cans; and plastic bottles & jugs. The table below identifies the materials and how to prepare them for recycling.

Please follow these directions and if an item you have is not on this list dispose of it properly. If you are not sure please call us at the number provided below.

MATERIAL	WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED	HOW TO PREPARE FOR RECYCLING	WHAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED
Newspaper	Clean Newspaper (including inserts).	Separate from mixed paper.	Wet or dirty newspaper.
Mixed Paper	Office paper, junk mail, phone books, magazines, catalogs, glossy paper.	Separate from newspaper.	Laminated paper, tissue paper, hard-backed books.
Paperboard	Clean food boxes, paper towel rolls, shoe boxes, tissue boxes.	Include with Mixed Paper.	Wax coated food boxes, juice cartons, ice cream containers.
Cans	Aluminum & tin food and beverage cans.	Rinse containers, leave labels on.	Pie plates, aluminum foil, pesticide or herbicide spray cans.
Plastic Bottles & Jugs	Plastic bottles, coded #1 thru #7. Containers <1 gallon in size.	Rinse containers, remove lids, leave labels on.	Container >1 gallon in size, toys, motor oil bottles, laundry baskets and chairs.

Collection Instructions:

- Please rinse all containers and remove lids.
- Place newspaper and magazines/junk mail into **separate** plastic bags.
- Place at curbside by **7:00am** on day of scheduled pick up.
- If your collection day falls on a holiday your pickup will be the **next business day**.
