Latex & Oil based paint <u>will not</u> be accepted at this collection event. Visit our website for ways to manage your paint.

All Clinton County homeowners or residential tenants are eligible to bring their household hazardous waste to the collection event.

Due to regulatory requirements, business, commercial and industrial entities are not eligible.
