JULY 15, 2024

The Wayne Township Board of Supervisors held a meeting on July 15, 2024, at 7:00 p.m., at the Wayne Township Municipal Building, with James B. Maguire, David W. Calhoun, and Terry Condo present.

Public Participation

Resident Karis Kellander asked the Board of Supervisors if they would pay for advertising for the Goat Hill School Reunion again this year.

Chairman Maguire made a motion to approve the request and pay for advertising for the Goat Hill School Reunion; seconded by Supervisor Condo, MCU.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Chairman Maguire asked if there were any questions on the June 17, 2024, meeting minutes, there being none, Supervisor Calhoun made a motion to approve the minutes as presented; seconded by Supervisor Condo, MCU.

Approval of Treasurer's Report

Supervisor Calhoun made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report as submitted; seconded by Supervisor Condo, MCU.

Recreation Committee

A report was not presented during the meeting.

Zoning Officer's Report

Zoning Officer Terry Crawford presented the monthly report to the Supervisors which included five land use permits issued for the month that included one new construction.

Monthly Engineer's Report

John Segursky, P.E., provided the following report for the month:

Linnippi Village Road Project

All the paving work is complete. The contractor must complete curbing, pavement backup and line painting and John will contact HRI, Inc. about completing the project.

Merrill Property Flood Permit

John Segursky, P.E. has been in contact with the representative from FEMA and prepared a review letter with items that need addressed prior to approval of the drawings of the Merrill Property by MKR Architects and provided a copy of the review letter to the Board of Supervisors.

Old Business:

There was no old business presented for discussion.

New Business:

Supervisor Calhoun spoke to the Supervisors about the Recreation Committee and its proposal to become a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization for donations made to the Committee to be tax deductible.

Solicitor Ryan explained that the Recreation Committee cannot “stand alone” and is under the Township’s umbrella. In addition, charitable contributions to townships are tax-deductible per the Internal Revenue Code if the donation is for a public purpose.

Supervisor Calhoun also mentioned that the Recreation Committee would like to purchase a “Santa Hut” for the Nature Park at an estimated cost of \$6,000.00 and would like to either solicit for donations or request the Township pay for the purchase.

A discussion followed and it was the consensus of the Board that the cost outweighs the benefits of purchasing a “Santa Hut” for the Nature Park.

Approval of Invoices

Supervisor Calhoun made a motion to approve the invoices as submitted, seconded by Supervisor Condo, MCU.
